Concretion is a specific mineral aggregate, a solid and hard shape, formed by thickening and joining minerals around a certain core in sedimentary rocks and soils. The name concretion was created by combining the Latin words con (together) and crescere (growth) - concretio. Probably the most famous concretions in the world are "Moqui Marbles" from Utah, USA and Septaria.
